## Welcome to the Friends of the Wheaton Public Library 2011 Book Sale!

To make the sale safe and enjoyable for everyone, the following rules will be enforced:

- No electronic devices used to seek information about books may be used at any time during the sale (this includes but is not limited to scanners, PDAs, laptops, Blackberries & cell phones). Anyone using such devices will be immediately expelled from the sale.
- You may not enter the sale with backpacks, food, drinks, roller blades, skateboards, strollers, or carts. We encourage you to bring empty, recyclable tote bags.
- You are allowed only one box of books in the sale room at any given time. Additional boxes must be placed in the holding room and are considered sold.
- You must keep the aisles open as much as possible. In particular you may not stack books on the floor or tables to sort through them, you may not sit on the floor, and you may not leave your selections unattended. Selections left unattended will be returned immediately to the selling floor. You may place items in the holding area if you wish to continue shopping. You may not sort books in the holding room. Electronic devices are not allowed in the holding area. Items left in the holding area at the end of the evening will be returned to the selling floor.
- Blankets or other textiles create tripping hazards and their use to cover boxes of books is prohibited.
- You may not hoard books or scoop books from the tables to decide whether you want to buy them. This is unfair to other shoppers. Anyone doing this will be expelled.
- Children must be supervised at all times.
- Cash and checks are accepted. No credit or debit cards.
- The library reserves the right to limit the number of shoppers in any of the sale rooms.
- Civility and good manners are expected of all participants at all times.
- *We reserve the right to expel anyone who hoards, scoops tables, shoves, pushes, or exhibits any other boorish behavior that brings us close to tears.*
