YFIC Adams / YRACK ADA

***Watership Down*** by Richard Adams

Chronicles the adventures of a group of rabbits searching for a safe place to establish a new warren where they can live in peace.

JFIC Alcott, L / JPB Alcott, L / YRACK ACL ***Little Women***, by Louisa May Alcott

Chronicles the humorous and sentimental four March sisters as they grow into young ladies in 19th century New England.

Fiction Anderson, S / RACK AND

***Winesburg, Ohio***, by Sherwood Anderson

A collection of short stories set in a small, fictional Ohio town. These sparse, remarkable tales revolve around the town's young reporter George Willard and his growing want for adventure.

YFIC Austen / RACK AUS

***Pride and Prejudice*** by Jane Austen

Mrs. Bennet scrambles to find husbands for her five daughters in a gentle satire of the foibles and prejudices of human nature.

***Jane Eyre***, by Charlotte Bronte

An unwanted orphan turned governess takes work in a house shrouded in mystery and plagued by haunted cries and terrible illusions.

***Robinson Crusoe***, by Daniel Defoe

An account of the hero's shipwreck and escape to an uninhabited island, where he makes himself a comfortable home.

The hero, Pip, reared by humble relatives, is informed he is to be made a gentleman of "great expectations" by a mysterious, unknown patron.

***The Count of Monte Cristo***,

by Alexandre Dumas

Relates a sailor's preparation for and execution of revenge against the three men responsible for his fifteen years in prison.

***The Three Musketeers***, by Alexandre Dumas

D'Argagnan arrives in Paris one day in 1625 and manages to be involved in three duels with musketeers who become his best friends.

Amidst the decadence of wealthy Jazz Age society, an enigmatic millionaire is obsessed with an elusive, spoiled young woman.

Innocence ends and savagery emerges when English schoolboys stranded on a desert island attempt to set up a civilization of their own.

Fiction Hemingway

***The Nick Adams Stories***, by Ernest

Hemingway

These short stories represent, along with eight previously unpublished stories, the complete collection of Hemingway's most recurring and beloved character.

**To Kill a Mockingbird**, by Harper Lee

Scout tells of her life in a small 1930s Alabama town and of her father's courtroom defense of a black man accused of assaulting a white woman.

**The Call of the Wild**, by Jack London

The story of a house dog sold to Alaska gold miners as a sled dog for the gold rush of 1898. Through various owners and experiences he becomes a tougher and smarter animal.

**Anne of Green Gables**, by L.M. Montgomery

Anne, an eleven year old orphan, is sent by mistake to live with a lonely middle aged brother and sister on a Prince Edward Island farm and proceeds to make an unforgettable impression on everyone around her.

**The Highwayman**, by Alfred Noyes

The comic version of the poem about the highwayman and his true love, the innkeeper's daughter.
