AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: ADVENTURE OF THE WESTERN STAR

Japp stalks a slippery jewel thief while Poirot excitedly prepares to entertain a beautiful Belgian film star. Poirot and Japp find themselves on parallel tracks when the film star asks Poirot's advice about threatening notes she's received concerning the Western Star, her fabulous diamond. But the actress declines to let Poirot safeguard the gem because she wants to wear it while visiting the home of the woman who owns the gem's companion, the Eastern Star. When a group of acquaintances attend a costume ball as classical characters from Italian comedy, two of them end up dead. After sifting through the small but telling clues, Poirot dramatically reveals his conclusions on a BBC radio broadcast.

An old friend names Hercule Poirot executor of his new will, in which he names as sole beneficiary his young and scholarly ward, but the man dies suddenly and the will disappears.

Hercule Poirot has returned to his native land to witness Chief Inspector Japp receive an award from the Belgian government. The detective recounts for his old friend a difficult murder case Poirot solved when he was on the Belgian police force.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: HOW DOES YOUR GARDEN GROW?

At a flower show, an elderly woman corners Poirot, introducing herself and giving him the curious gift of a seed packet. Later, Poirot receives a letter from the woman asking for his help with trouble in her household. Poirot and Ms. Lemon travel to the woman's home in Surrey where they find that the trouble has tragically escalated. The house's garden leads Poirot to the truth.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: THE KIDNAPPED PRIME MINISTER

Poirot is called in on a case at the highest level when the prime minister is kidnapped in France on his way to an international conference. Earlier, a gang of hooligans has attacked the PM's car as it traveled from Windsor to the boat train. With only 32 hours to solve the crime before the start of the conference, Poirot perplexingly pursues his investigation in England instead of taking off for France as expected.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: LORD EDGWARE DIES

Based on the novel by Agatha Christie.

Poirot agrees to visit the husband of a famous actress to urge him to reconsider her request for a divorce. Edgware insists that he has already agreed to his wife's request. Yet, within twenty-four hours, he is found murdered.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: THE MILLION DOLLAR BOND ROBBERY

A bank manager's close brush with a hit-and-run driver prompts the bank to call in Poirot to investigate. The manager has been chosen by the bank to carry a million dollars in Liberty bonds to New York on the maiden voyage of the Queen Mary, but someone appears to be trying to stop him.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: MURDER IN MESOPOTAMIA

Based on the novel by Agatha Christie.

An archeologist's beautiful but unpopular wife is murdered while the couple is in the Middle East excavating an historical site. At the request of local authorities a vacationing Hercule Poirot takes on the case.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: THE MURDER OF ROGER ACKROYD

Based on the novel by Agatha Christie.

Poirot comes into possession of a journal, which recounts the story of a murder.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: THE MYSTERY OF HUNTER'S LODGE

Poirot accompanies Hastings to a grouse shoot at a country estate. After coming down with a fever, Poirot bids adieu to the hunting party. That evening, a murder occurs at the lodge, requiring a revived Poirot to lead the hunt for the killer.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: THE MYSTERY OF THE SPANISH CHEST

Poirot is asked to a dinner party to meet a beautiful woman thought to be in danger from her jealous husband. When a murder occurs during the evening, Poirot finds a telling hole in a large chest in the sitting room.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: THE PLYMOUTH EXPRESS

An Australian mining magnate persuades a reluctant Poirot to investigate his daughter's latest suitor, a French count who may be another gold digger. As Poirot and Hastings observe, the couple meet for tea and the count shows the woman some bearer bonds he claims to be carrying for his new employer, the Bank of Paris. After a fateful train trip, the case becomes a murder mystery and the count a prime suspect. A paperboy's account and Ms. Lemon's filing system give Poirot the final clues he needs to finger the killer.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: THE THEFT OF THE ROYAL RUBY

Poirot reluctantly agrees to help recover a priceless Egyptian royal jewel for the sake of international relations,, not the dissolute prince it was taken from. A holiday visit to the home of an Egyptologist leads him to the jewel and the thief.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: THE TRAGEDY AT MARSDON MANOR

Poirot responds to an urgent call from a country hotel only to find that he's being asked to stoop to fictional crime solving. But a real crime equal to his talents soon occurs at a nearby, possibly haunted, manor house.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: THE UNDERDOG

"Poirot invites himself along when Hastings goes off to play golf, not for the sport but for the chance to see some Belgian miniature bronzes at dinner. Though it's Miss Lemon who helps Hastings with his golf game, Poirot is called on to defend another underdog"--Container.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: WASPS' NEST

Poirot, Hastings, and Japp attend a garden fete where Hastings is trying out his new camera. Poirot meets a young writer, the son of an old friend, who joyously introduces them to his fiancée. When Poirot playfully reads the tea leaves in the young woman's cup, he sees something disturbing. A tenacious wasps' nest in the young writer's garden proves central to the trouble Poirot foresaw. Hastings' photos and Japp's off-duty eagle eye help Poirot unravel the mystery in time to intervene.

AGATHA CHRISTIE'S POIROT: YELLOW IRIS

"Poirot picks up a murder case he had been forced to drop two years earlier in Buenos Aires. A British heiress named Iris had been poisoned while dining in a restaurant. When the woman's husband plans a reconstruction of the fateful night. Poirot takes Iris' place at the table and sets a trap for the killer"--Container.

His world heavyweight champion title thus stripped from him entirely for political reasons, the champ sets about to win back his crown, culminating in a legendary unification bout against George Foreman in Zaire, dubbed the "Rumble in the Jungle."

ALICE DOESN'T LIVE HERE ANYMORE

Alice Hyatt's husband dies accidentally, leaving her to care for their son, Tommy. Unskilled, Alice decides to return to Monterey, California, where she was once a singer. Because she is short of funds, she must work her way there. They encounter difficult situations along the way and a rancher, David Barrie.

ALICE IN WONDERLAND

The adventure begins as Alice slips down a rabbit hole and tumbles into Wonderland, a dream land where the official language is Jabberwocky and the official sense is nonsense.
