GALLIPOLI

Based on a story by Peter Weir.

GANDHI

Gandhi was a small, modest man who led an entire country to freedom. This is a collage of strength and endurance set in panoramic vistas that celebrate India and its people, where Gandhi's spirit ultimately triumphs.

GANGS OF NEW YORK

In 1846, waves of Irish immigrants poured into the New York neighborhood of Five Points. "Billy the Butcher" bands his fellow "Native Americans" into a gang to take on the Irish gang "The Dead Rabbits," organized by Priest Vallon. After a bloody clash Vallon is dead and his son ends up in a brutal reform school. In 1862, that boy returns to seek vengeance against the man that killed his father.

THE GARDEN OF THE FINZI-CONTINIS

Based on the novel of the same title by Giorgio Bassani.

In Italy in 1938, Mussolini's anti-Semitic edicts begin to isolate the Jews from their communities. Among them are the Finzi-Continis, an aristocratic Jewish family forced for the first time to acknowledge the world beyond its fenced garden.

A writer murders the blackmailer of his actress wife and buries the body under the backyard gazebo.

THE GENERAL

A comedy about a young southerner who repeatedly tried to enlist in the Confederate Army but who was refused because he was of more value to the cause as the engineer of The General. (Silent film with music score.)

GENTLEMAN'S AGREEMENT

A writer who is assigned to do a magazine series on anti-Semitism decides to pose as a Jew, and soon discovers what it is like to be a victim of religious intolerance.

GEORGE A. ROMERO'S KNIGHTRIDERS

A cult classic of modern-day bikers who look and act like Knights of the Round Table! Fierce fighting on roaring steel steeds prove who is bravest, who is strongest, who deserves to be king. Good faces Evil head-on, swords drawn... The winner wears the crown! But what if Evil wins.
