

Listening to Library Audio Books on a Kindle

MP3 audio books are compatible

* The base model Kindle released on 9/28/11 *does not* support audio



Requirements:

- Computer with OverDrive Media Console installed
 - Kindle with audio support* and a USB cable
 - Wheaton Public Library card

- ▶ Install OverDrive Media Console software from eMediaLibrary on your computer

 - ▶ Search for an MP3 audio book at eMediaLibrary and place it in your digital basket
<http://emedialibrary.lib.overdrive.com>
 - ▶ Check it out using your Wheaton Public Library card
 - ▶ Click the Download button and OverDrive Media Console will open automatically
 - ▶ Close OverDrive Media Console after all the parts have been downloaded
 - ▶ Transfer it to your Kindle manually
 1. Plug your Kindle into your computer using the USB cable
 2. Go to C:\My Documents\My Media\MP3 Audiobooks
 3. Right-click the folder with the title you wish to transfer
 4. Click Copy
 5. Go to My Computer and find the Kindle, double click to open it
 6. Right click the Audible folder
 7. Click Paste and wait for the files to transfer
 - ▶ Disconnect/eject your Kindle from the computer
 - ▶ Enjoy listening to your audio book

Remove audiobook files from your Kindle manually

1. Plug your Kindle into your computer using the USB cable
2. Go to My Computer and find the Kindle, double click to open it
3. Double click the Audible folder to open it
4. Select the folder and/or files you wish to delete
5. Press the Delete button

Note:

- Audio books are checked out for two weeks.
- They may not be renewed, but may be checked out again if no one is waiting.
- They may *not* be returned early.
