

# Read to Succeed – Winter Reading Program 2016-17

## IMPORTANT DATES

- December 1 – First day to read books that are eligible for logging
- December 5 – First day to log reading time at the Reference Desk
- December 14 – First Weekly Drawing
- February 4 – Last day to log reading time and submit completed reading log
- February 5 – Grand Prize Drawing and final Weekly Drawing

## RULES

- Open to grades 3-8
- No library card required
- Books may be read in any format (ebook, audiobook, etc.)
- All reading time logged must have been completed on or after December 1
- Those in grades 3-5 may participate in Read to Succeed AND Cozy Up with Elephant and Piggie (Youth Services Winter Reading Program) and may log the same reading time/books in both programs
- Weekly Drawing winners are not eligible to win another prize until the Grand Prize Drawing

## INSTRUCTIONS

- Pick up a Reading Log at the Reference Desk on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor or in Teenspace on the main floor.
- Each time you complete 30 minutes of reading, write the title of the book/magazine/comic/etc. in a square on your Reading Log.
- Bring your Reading Log to the Reference Desk on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor and a librarian will stamp your Reading Log for each completed square.
  - One stamp = One Weekly Drawing entry
  - A librarian will give you a drawing slip for each square completed. Please print your name and phone number neatly.
  - You may log one square at a time (if you visit the library a lot) or you may log several at once.
- Once you have completed nine squares (4.5 hours of reading time), bring your completed Reading Log to the Reference Desk and you will receive one entry for the Grand Prize Drawing.

## PRIZES

- Weekly drawing prize packs may include:

  - Books
  - Coupons from local businesses
